



"Be prepared in all aspects of life" is what Boy Scouting has brought to high school student Collin Leigh. He believes that Scouting has given shape and direction to young men's lives, opening up many fields of studies and doors to their promising futures.

One of Collin's recent projects, earning him an Eagle Scout Gardening Merit Badge, has been the construction of two raised wooden flower beds for our ADC members and staff. The assembly took 3 days with the help

of 4 to 5 other Scouts. The raised beds are constructed of pressure treated wood, 40 inches high, 4x4 feet wide and 1 foot deep. Sixteen, 1 foot squares of soil were allotted for each member to plant annuals, perennials and herbs. Much thought and consideration went into this wonderful springtime project, including indoor seed plantings of marigolds, morning glory and hummingbird flowers, which will be transplanted to the beds around Mother's Day.

Thank you Collin, Basking Ridge Boy Scout Troop 555, your family and for your generous contribution to the well-being of our members here at the ADC. Your vision for our garden has enhanced the days ahead of this spring and for many years to come.
